Purpose: The purpose of the Faithful Saints Recognition is to honor persons, 60 years or older, who exemplify positive images of aging at every level of the church and/or community. Further, this recognition offers an opportunity at the local and presbytery levels to recognize faithful saints who, by their example, serve as role models to all the generations for maturing with a sense of God's grace.

Focus: When submitting a person for this recognition, please focus exclusively on the person's later life activities.

Process: The Presbytery of Coastal Carolina invites your session to submit one person for the Faithful Saint Recognition. **Two Faithful Saints luncheons** are offered on May 2: St. Andrews-Covenant Presbyterian Church, Wilmington and Trinity Presbyterian, Laurinburg. Nominees can choose preferred location.

- What contributions has the nominee made in the life of his/her congregation and community since reaching the age of 60?
- How is this person a role model to other generations and his/her generation as to how to live fully, particularly in one's later years?
- How have his/her gifts and talents been exhibited, particularly in creative ways?
- How does this person's life bear witness to Christ working in him or her?
