

July 29, 2017; Jürgen Moltmann, the First Three Books - Moltmann was a prominent and revered European theologian whose work revolutionized theology in the second half of the 20th century the way Barth's Commentary on Romans did in the early 20th century. This seminar will trace his biography from a prisoner of war during the Second World War to his groundbreaking efforts to understand and incorporate Latin American Liberation Theology into mainstream Western Theology and then summarize the basic themes of Moltmann's first three books:

- *Theology of Hope* based on the event of Jesus' resurrection,
- *The Crucified God* focusing on Good Friday, and
- *The Church in the Power of the Spirit* dealing with Pentecost.

This presentation will help our us to think about and interpret these three crucial events in the Gospel. The leader will be Dr. Ronald Crossley, Dean of the Elder Ministries Program of the Presbytery of Coastal Carolina and former Dean and Professor of Theology at St. Andrews University and Professor of Theology at Columbia Theological Seminary.
